

4- Corner Fold Up Card

1. Cut 2 pieces of cardstock 4-1/2" X 9".
2. Score each piece landscape at 2-1/4"
Fold each piece on the score line towards the middle and fold the other side to meet that fold at the middle.
3. Cut about 1/8" inch off of one of the pieces on the long side. Use this piece for the inside layer. This will make folding the card up much easier.
4. Glue layers together like the diagram here.
5. For the COLORED layers. cut:
Back of card, cut: 4-3/4" X 4-3/4"
Inside center of card, cut: 4-1/4" X 4-1/4"
For the 4 sides, cut 4 @ 2" X 4-1/4"
6. For the WHITE
inside layer, cut" 3-7/8" X 3-7/8"

I used a 1-1/4" circle punch for the circles inside on the flaps.
Stamp borders on all sides first, then fold like a box and stamp the flowers.

I found the basic card for this project on Dawn Griffith's blog, however I made mine larger and added layers mainly because I used some 65lb. cardstock instead of 80lb. Consequently the ink bled through, so I decided to layer the card.

I took apart a 5" envelope to use for a template for the envelope.
